

Please be aware that CCTV is in operation at Manor farm Camping.  
 Manor Farm is a working farm Please help keep it a safe, secure & pleasant place for all our customers by adhering to the following site rules.

1.	Any person staying or entering Manor Farm Camp Site must agree to the following rules and the CS Rules.
2.	Pitches must be vacated by 11:45am on the day of departure unless otherwise arranged with the office. Exceptions can be made please ask if you wish to keep your pitch on later.
3.	No pets on the camping field. Please keep camping gates closed to deter farm animals entering.
4.	Please be aware that the farm dogs have a free rein of Manor Farm. Do not feed the dogs.
5.	Do not feed or touch any animals on site.
6.	There are children and loose animals on site please look out for them at all times when travelling in your vehicle. <b>Max speed limit on site is 5mph.</b> Pedestrians and animals have the right of way!
7.	The children's park is for children under 11yrs old to enjoy, at <u>your</u> risk. Please supervise your children at all times. Manor Farm Camping holds no responsibility for accidents in the play area Misuse of the park or facilities will not be tolerated.
8.	<b>Motorcycles</b> and <b>work vehicles</b> are only permitted on the site by prior permission
9.	No fires to be lit anywhere on the camp site with the exception of hired pits & BBQ's. BBQ's should be kept off the grass and not emptied into waste bins. Disposal of cooled BBQ's to be agreed with site manager. Only fire pits hired from the site may be used after agreeing to the pit safety rules.
10.	Do not block the gateways, Cars must be parked so as to allow access for emergency and farm vehicles at all times. Keep within your pitch boundary. 1 car per pitch.
11.	Ball games must be kept a safe distance from campers, their equipment and their vehicles. If you or your family cause damage to someone's property you are responsible.
13.	<b>No</b> fire-arms, fireworks, floating lanterns or dangerous weapons are allowed on the site.
14.	Fishing is <b>Not</b> permitted.
15.	It is expressly forbidden to use fire extinguishers or water buckets for any purpose other than to extinguish a fire.
16.	Do not overload the electric sockets.
17.	Only breathable ground sheets are allowed to be used.
18.	<b>Children under the age of 16</b> must be supervised at all times and accompanied around the site. Please remember this is a working farm.
19.	Be aware there is <b>Open Water</b> on the site. Swimming in the ponds is strictly <b>forbidden</b> .
20.	Please ensure your children do not play in or around the shower block or pond. Only Children supervised by an adult are permitted in these areas.
21.	<b>Absolutely no playing or climbing on any farm machinery, plant, fences or materials.</b>
22.	Please stay in the designated camping areas and do not enter farm areas, private garden, buildings or equipment.
22.	The ground can be uneven please use footwear around the site and take care where surfaces are uneven. Please do not pick, eat or cut down any plants on and around the site.
23.	No smoking in the shower block
24.	Smoking on site is only permitted on your pitch. Please dispose of cigarettes responsibly and do not stub them out and leave on the pitch / ground – this is littering.
25.	Do not leave litter anywhere on site. Please use the bins provided and recycle as much as possible
26.	The fire point & fire bucket are next to the drinking water tap in the camp field. Make yourself & family familiar with this. Tampering (or your children tampering) with the bell or bucket for any other reason than an emergency will result in you been told to leave the site immediately with no refund.
27.	Do not let your children play around the water taps. No water bomb please.
28.	<b>Dogs</b> are permitted on the Rally field. <b>NO</b> Dogs on the camp field or in the shower block. Your dogs mess is your mess please take care to clean it up and dispose of it properly. You will be told to leave the site if you do not clean up after your dog. All dogs must be on a lead at all times. Yapping dogs will not be tolerated, if you bring your dog away with you please do not leave it unattended. Please remember Not everyone is a dog lover.
29.	There is a strict ' <b>NO NOISE</b> ' rule after 10pm & before 8am. Please be considerate to others at all times, you will be asked to leave the site without refund if you do not respect this rule.
30.	Any contravention of these rules will render those concerned to be asked to leave the site immediately and without a refund.
31.	Children must be supervised at all times. The park is open from 9am – 9pm for supervised children under 11yrs old.
32.	Quiet time on site is from 10pm to 8am
33	Recycle all glass, plastic and cans in the blue bins or black bins around site. Do not leave camping equipment eg chairs, tents, airbeds at the bins please take them home.

We have tried to provide you with a safe and enjoyable site. This is a working farm and does have its hazards and dangers. Please ensure for yours and your families safety you follow the above rules. You will be asked to leave without refund if found to be breaking any of the above rules.
